



BYLAW NO. 1-2018

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUFFERIN No 190

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON A PORTIONS OF TOWNSHIP ROAD 200 (KSPC Bethune Mine Road – Road #1) FROM HIGHWAY #11 TO RANGE ROAD 252

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin #190, in the Province of Saskatchewan, pursuant to Section 8 (1) (g) and Section 12 of *The Municipalities Act*, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than sixty (60) kilometres per hour on the municipal road described as follows:
 - a. That portion of Township Road 200 located South of Sections 2 – 20-25-2 (Range Road 252 to Range Road 251).
2. Signs indicating the maximum speed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.
3. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than sixty (80) kilometres per hour on the municipal road described as follows:
 - a. That portion of Township Road 200 located South of Sections 1 – 20-25-2, Section 6-20-24-2, pt SW 5-20-24-2-300 m east of west quarter section line (Range Road 251 to Range Road to 300 m east of Range Road 245).
 - b. That portion of Township Road 200 located South of Sections pt SW 2– 20-23-2, pt SE 3-20-23-2,- 300 m west of east quarter section line (300 m west of Range Road 232 to Highway #11).
4. Signs indicating the maximum speed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area
5. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than sixty (100) kilometres per hour on the municipal road described as follows:
 - a. That portion of Township Road 200 located South of Sections 6,5,4–19-23-2 and South of SW 3-2-23-2 and pt SE 3-20-23-2,- to 300 m west of east quarter section line; South of Sections pt SW 5-20-24-2- to 300 m east of west quarter section line; SE 5-20-24-2 and South of Sections,4,3,2,1-20-24-2; (Range Road 251 to Range Road 252).
6. Signs indicating the maximum speed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone.

7. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
8. This bylaw comes into force and effect upon final passing thereof
